

THE SIXTH ANNUAL LITTLE EUROPE POST CHRISTMAS GIFT EXCHANGE

We know you don't always get what you want or need for Christmas so here's a quick and easy way to try and secure something you'll actually use, and to get rid of whatever crap that one cousin sends every year.

As per usual, the exchange will be open between the 26th and 29th of December. Cash is accepted, but direct swapping is preferred.

Climbing Paw. *My kid apparently told all my siblings that he wanted these, and none of them checked what others were buying him. Seeing that he doesn't have eight arms, I've got a few of these to offload.*

A bulky glove that resembles a cat's paw. The pads are coated in a high tech gripping surface, allowing for ease of climbing. Each glove counts as one installation of Grip Feet, but the user can't hold anything in the hand wearing the Climbing Paw, it's too big and fuzzy.

Poison Lipstick. 200eb. *I got this from my ex-husband. Guess he thought it was funny. Looking to trade for something I can give to an eight year old girl that he forgot to buy for instead.*

A poisonous gel worked into a stick of lipstick. The user takes an included antidote pill (50eb) that gives five hours of protection from the poison before applying it. For the next half an hour, on an unaware target, or as part of a grab, any kiss delivered by the user requires the receiver to pass a DV13 Resist Torture/Drugs check or take 3d6 damage directly to HP.

Sergey the SovOil Bear. 500eb. *I work for Petrochem, Petro! Chem!*

A two-foot tall animatronic bear with a fluffy and huggable exterior. Can sing patriotic songs. Can be linked to an Agent within 6 m/yds, taking 5 minutes to do so. After linking, Sergey will follow it's connected Agent at a maximum distance of 6m/yds, stopping if the Agent moves beyond this distance. Can be alternatively controlled directly from it's linked Agent.

1 Move, 5 HP. DV9 Electronics/Security Tech, 5 mins to counter.

Car Underglow Kit. 100eb. *My girl thinks this is tacky, looking to swap this for something I can use, or her for someone nicer.*

A series of lights mounted onto the underside of a land vehicle. Color is controlled by a switch mounted near the steering wheel, or via interface plug. Counts as one installation of Light Tattoos for those driving, riding in, sitting on, or leaning against the vehicle.

Perfect Blend by Kendachi. 500eb. *It's nice, but I can't afford the fruit to make these kind of drinks regularly. Besides, I've got a kid in the house, and this thing is sharp.*

A blender that makes use of Kendachi's experience with blades to produce the smoothest smoothies you'll find outside a corporate resort, supplemented with Kendachi's custom mix of vital vitamins and minerals. Requires fruit, either purchased or provided by a Fresh Food Lifestyle. Grants a +1 bonus to Endurance for eight hours after drinking a freshly prepared drink produced by this item.

If an item is inserted into the powered blender, it takes damage as if it has been struck by a Very Heavy Melee Weapon every round it remains inside.

An Unusual Painting, by an Unnamed Artist . 500eb. *Can't tell which way up this is supposed to go and it's irritating me.*

A peculiar piece of modern art, consisting of streaks and splodges of paint on canvas that are random, but somehow captivating. Whoever made this had a keen insight into the human condition, probably. It's an excellent ice breaker at least.

Provides a general +1 to Conversation to those inside a room where the painting is prominently displayed, as everyone tries to work out what the hell it's supposed to be.
